Thank you for your interest in our Family Field Day to be held **Saturday**, **September 26, 2015** rain or shine at Elkhorn Lake Hunt Club from **8:00 to 3 p.m**. Parents or guardians are expected (required) to attend with their children, although older



teens (15 and older) may attend with parental permission and signed liability waiver. Parents are the best judge of a child's desire and ability to profit from this event. (Suggested ages 8 and up) Bring a water bottle, bug spray, sun screen and a hat, long pants and sturdy footwear to make yourself more comfortable. If you cannot swim, a life preserver is strongly suggested for around the pond area. All seminar equipment will be provided.

Scheduled activities and seminars will run throughout the day, and all sessions are attended by all participants. Events include:

- Fishing- catfish, blue gill and bass out of the pond.
- Archery Range staffed by the Christian Bowhunters Association
- Shotgun- Elkhorn staff with help from qualified volunteers
- Rifle range with supervision from our ODNR friends.
