Thank you for your interest in our Family Field Day to be held **Saturday, September 28th**, rain, shine, or snow at Elkhorn Lake Hunt Club from **8:00 to 3 p.m.** This event allows families to try, on average, between 6-8 different outdoor activities and ask questions of individuals that already are proficient in that activity. How better to know if you like something than to try it and ask the experts?



If you are able, please pre-register so that we can better prepare for your arrival and not have to wait in line filling out paperwork. Walk ins are always welcomed! Check out our Family Field Day event on our Facebook page for updated information as we get closer to the date. Also, feel free to reach out to us via email or phone if you have any questions.

Parents or guardians are expected (required) to attend with their children, although older teens (15 and older) may attend with parental permission and signed liability waiver. Parents are the best judge of a child's desire and ability to profit from this event. (Suggested ages 8 and up) Bring a water bottle, bug spray, sunscreen and a hat, long pants, and sturdy footwear to make yourself more comfortable. If you cannot swim, a life preserver is strongly suggested for around the pond area. All seminar equipment will be provided.

Scheduled activities and seminars will run throughout the day, and all sessions are attended by all participants. Events include:

- ↪ Fishing- catfish, blue gill and bass out of the pond.
- ↪ Archery Range - staffed by the Christian Bowhunters Association
- ↪ Shotgun- Elkhorn staff with help from qualified volunteers
- ↪ Rifle range - with supervision from our ODNR friends.



Additional activities may include:

- ↪ Boat Safety (ODNR Division of Watercraft)
- ↪ Pond ecology
- ↪ Kayaking

↪ Turkey Hunting (NWTF)

↪ To participate in **Youth Pheasant Hunt**, a child **must be at least 12 years old**, have a hunter education certificate, valid youth hunting license, wear hunter orange, and participate with a licensed responsible adult. A separate liability waiver/application is required. Participation times will be chosen **AT THE EVENT**, after we have verified who has arrived.

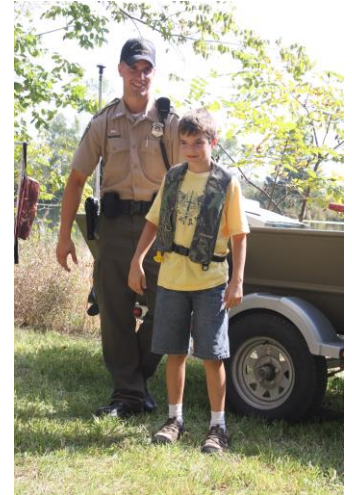
